LIQUIDATOR'S FOURTH CLAIMS REPORT, RECOMMENDATION AND PROPOSAL FOR REVISIONS TO SECOND CLAIMS REPORT, RECOMMENDATION AND APPLICATION FOR ORDER APPROVING SAME, AND APPROVAL OF INITIAL DISTRIBUTION

COMES NOW, Troy Downing, as Liquidator of the above-captioned insurance company ("CareConcepts"), by and through the undersigned counsel, files herewith his Fourth Claims Report, applies to the Court for an Order approving the Liquidator's report specified herein and further authorizing the Liquidator to revise certain recommended amounts reported in the Second Claims Report and approve of an initial distribution.

This application is made pursuant to the Montana Insurers Supervision, Rehabilitation and Liquidation Act, Mont. Code Ann. Title 33, Chapter 2, Part 13; specifically, Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1372, wherein the Liquidator is required to review all claims duly filed in the liquidation proceedings,

make such further investigation as he deems necessary, and submit a claims report to the Court containing his claim recommendations.

In support of his report, recommendation and application, the Liquidator respectfully shows the following:

- 1. Between the entry of the Order of Liquidation on August 10, 2016, and March 31, 2017, the latter being the Claims Bar Date, the Liquidator issued one-hundred and nine (109) Notices of Liquidation and Proof of Claim (POC) forms, with instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants and other potential claimants and/or creditors of CareConcepts.
- 2. On November 5, 2016, notice of the liquidation was published in the Missoulian newspaper, a newspaper of countywide circulation in the County of Missoula, Montana, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 3. On November 4, 2016, notice of the liquidation was published in the New York Daily News newspaper, with a circulation in Manhattan, Bronx, Westchester, Rockland, Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island, Nassau and Suffolk, and the lower Hudson Valley, New York, Fairfield and New Haven, Connecticut, and the 14 counties in Northern New Jersey, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 4. On or before the Claims Bar Date of March 31, 2017, the Liquidator received one-hundred and nine (109) timely-filed POCs. The Liquidator also received one (1) late-filed claim.
- 5. On February 19, 2020, this Court issued an Order Approving First Claims Report and Recommendation of Liquidator for thirty-seven (37) claims. Twenty (20) of the thirty-seven claims were denied in whole.
- 6. An additional forty-nine (49) claims were approved by this Court on April 23, 2021, by Order Approving Second Claims Report and Recommendation of Liquidator. Thirty-nine (39) of

these claims were denied in whole or determined to be subordinate to Class 2 claims.<sup>1</sup> Subordinate claims were only reviewed to the extent of determining their class of claim.<sup>2</sup>

- 7. An additional eight (8) claims were approved by this Court on August 23, 2021, by Order Approving Third Claims Report and Recommendation of Liquidator. Two (2) of these eight (8) claims were denied in whole.
- 8. An additional nine (9) claims have now been adjudicated. One (1) of these claims was denied in whole.
- 9. All remaining POCs, totaling seven (7), are presently under evaluation.

  Determinations, once concluded, will be forwarded to remaining claimants for their concurrence or objection.
- 10. Attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein is a Schedule listing the names and addresses of nine (9) claimants holding a priority class 2 claim as defined by Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1371, the POC number assigned by the Liquidator and the valuation of the claim proposed by the Liquidator.
- 11. Attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein is a schedule, for information only, listing the names and addresses of two (2) claimants holding a priority class 2 claim as defined by Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1371 that were subject to the Second Claims Report, the POC number, the amounts allowed by this Court by Order entered April 23, 2021, and the Liquidator's revised recommended amounts.
- 12. Provided the Court approves this Fourth Claims Report as described above, the Liquidator proposes this Court then approve an initial distribution to all Court approved Class 2

claimants. The distribution will be in the amount of \$500,000, representing an approximate 7.2% distribution as depicted on Exhibit C, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

13. In further support of this Report, Recommendation and Application, the Liquidator has attached as Exhibit D and incorporated herein the affidavit of Michael J. FitzGibbons, Special Deputy Liquidator.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator prays the Court issue an Order approving this Fourth Claims Report, claims' recommendations and proposed initial distribution, all in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. §§ 33-2-1371 & 1373, as well as such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.

Michael J. FitzGibbons, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

1. I am the Special Deputy Liquidator of CareConcepts Insurance, Inc. a Risk Retention Group ("CareConcepts"). I was appointed to my position by then Liquidator, Monica J. Lindeen, Commissioner of Securities and Insurance, Montana State Auditor, and am continuing as Special Deputy Liquidator under the current Liquidator, Troy Downing, Commissioner of Securities and Insurance, Montana State Auditor.



- 2. I am over 21 years of age and suffer no legal disability.
- 3. By virtue of my appointment as Special Deputy Liquidator, I have been actively and personally involved in the liquidation of CareConcepts at all times since it was placed into liquidation, including the matters addressed in this Affidavit. My responsibilities as the Special Deputy Liquidator include supervision and oversight of the liquidation process. I am familiar with the claims process and with the claims that have been filed. Therefore, I have personal knowledge of the matters addressed in this Affidavit.
- 4. The claims process has included the following components, each and every one of which has been followed:
  - a. Notice of CareConcepts' liquidation was given in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1346(1).
  - b. In accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1346(2), the notice specified that the last date to file a timely proof of claim with the Liquidator was March 31, 2017. Timely proofs of claim must be postmarked no later than 5:00 p.m. Mountain Daylight Time, on such date.
  - c. The Liquidator's Proof of Claim ("POC") forms comply with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1365 and provided notice thereof in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1346(2).
  - d. As the duly appointed Special Deputy Liquidator, I have considered each of the eight (8) POCs subject to this Claims Report, in accordance with the requirements of the Montana Insurers Supervision, Rehabilitation, and Liquidation Act, Mont. Code Ann. 33-2-1301 et seq. (the "Act").
  - e. I am administering the POC process. I initially contracted with ICARMS, LLC to perform the adjudication of the POCs. In their stead, I subsequently contracted with Glynloen Consulting. I charged ICARMS, LLC and Glynloen Consulting with the responsibility to make recommendations to the Liquidator as to the validity, valuation, and priority of each POC. The Liquidator, and/or his duly appointed Special Deputy, then independently approves or denies

Glynloen Consulting's recommendations in whole or in part and submits the same to this Court for approval.

- f. Each POC subject to this Claims Report contains the necessary claim file documentation for the Liquidator's recommendation thereon.
- g. To the extent this Claims Report includes claims that were denied in whole or in part, notice of such denial complying with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1368(1) was provided to the affected claimants and either a timely objection was made by the affected claimants, or the objection was resolved by mutual agreement.
- 5. I am submitting this Affidavit in support of Liquidator's Fourth Claims Report, Recommendation and Proposal for Revision to Second Claims Report, Recommendation & Application for Order Approving Same, and Approval of Initial Distribution ("Report, Recommendation and Application"), which pertains to nine (9) Class 2 claims as prescribed by Mont. Code Ann. §§ 33-2-1371 and -1372.
- 6. Between the entry of the Liquidation Order on August 10, 2016, and March 31, 2017, I caused to be issued one-hundred and nine (109) Notices of Liquidation and POC forms, with instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants, and/or other potential claimants and creditors of CareConcepts.
- 7. On November 5, 2016, notice of the liquidation was published in the Missoulian newspaper, a newspaper of countywide circulation in the County of Missoula, Montana, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 8. On November 4, 2016, notice of the liquidation was published in the New York Daily News newspaper, with a circulation in Manhattan, Bronx, Westchester, Rockland, Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island, Nassau and Suffolk, and the lower Hudson Valley, New York, Fairfield and New Haven, Connecticut, and the 14 counties in Northern New Jersey, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.

- 9. I received one-hundred and nine (109) timely-filed POCs by the bar date, March 31, 2017, and one (1) late-filed claim. Ninety-four (94) claims have been adjudicated and submitted to and approved by this Court by Orders entered on February 19, 2020, April 23, 2021, and August 23, 2021, respectively. Nine (9) claims are subject to this Claims Report. The remaining seven (7) claims are presently under evaluation.
- 10. Exhibit A, attached to the Report, Recommendation and Application and incorporated by reference, is a listing of the names and addresses of the nine (9) Class 2 claimants as defined in Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1371(2), the number assigned to each POC and the valuation of their POC as proposed by the Liquidator in accordance with Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1372.
- 11. Exhibit B, attached to the Report, Recommendation and Application and incorporated by reference, is a schedule, for information only, listing the names and addresses of two (2) claimants holding a priority Class 2 claim as defined by Mont. Code Ann. § 33-2-1371 that were subject to the Second Claims Report, the POC number, the amounts allowed by this Court by Order entered April 23, 2021, and the Liquidator's revised recommended amounts.
- 12. I seek to pay \$500,000 as an initial distribution which represents 7.2% of the Court approved amounts of Class 2 policyholder claims. Forty-two (42) of the one hundred ten (110) POCs will receive this initial distribution. The other 68 POCs were either denied in whole (43), are yet to be approved by this Court (7) or are subordinate to Class 2 claimants (18) and will not receive any distribution.
- 13. Adequate funds have been retained, following this initial distribution to assure fair and equitable treatment of all Class 2 policyholder claims which are unliquidated and undetermined on the date of this Application.
- 14. Exhibit C, attached to the Report, Recommendation and Application and incorporated by reference, is a listing of the names and addresses of each Class 2 policyholder claimant to whom the Liquidator seeks to make this initial distribution, the Court allowed amount, and the dollar amount of such distribution.

15. To the best of my knowledge and belief, the claims subject to this Report, Recommendation and Application are not subject to modification. If any additional factors hereafter come to my attention which may require any modification, such as third-party payments or releases of any such claims, I will immediately notify the Liquidator, and he and/or I will promptly bring those matters to the attention of this Court in an application to modify such claims.
